Park City is known for "the best snow on earth", outstanding dining, upscale shopping and vibrant nightlife. Park City is a high-altitude ski resort at 6,900 ft. and over 10,000 ft. at mountain top. To help get acclimated to the thin mountain air, drink plenty of water, limit alcohol consumption, avoid strenuous activity and get plenty of sleep for the first 24 hours.

Our trip leader, Karen Allabasatro and assistant trip leader, Rebecca Shaffer, have worked hard at putting together a thorough itinerary. 

#### **Transportation in Town**

**Peaks Hotel Shuttle:** Peaks Hotel has their own convenient shuttle that goes to Park City and Deer Valley lifts from 8:00 a.m.-4:45 p.m. and leaves every 30-minutes. Shuttle goes to Main Street and back to the hotel from 5:30-9:45 p.m. every 30-minutes.

**Village Transportation:** Park City Transit offers convenient bus service (every 20 mins in peak hours) throughout the Park City area. Bus goes to Park City and Canyons Village Lifts (front of Peaks Hotel), and to Main Street (back of Hotel). It also goes to Deer Valley. See Park City Peak front desk for information and brochure.

#### **Dinner reminders:**

Sometimes dining with a large group can be a bit challenging when it's time to split the bill. After dinner please keep following in mind when paying the bill –

- 1) If someone at your table did not drink, then they may not want to split the bill evenly. Consider giving them a break on the bill if you split it evenly.
- 2) In Breckenridge, Colorado the Combined Sales Tax Rate in 2024 = 9.04%
- 3) Check your tab carefully because some places add a gratuity to the bill. You may or may not want to supplement that.
- 4) For the wait staff at sit-down restaurants, the tip should be between 15% to 20% of the pretax bill.
- 5) Once you calculate your portion of the bill if you mark it up by 30% then that should cover the tax and tip adequately.
- 6) <u>Please consider bringing cash</u> as some restaurants don't process multiple credit cards.

## Other Activities to do in Park City

**Snowmobiling** – Our Travel Agent recommends North Forty Escapes for snowmobiling as well since they are the only company that offers hotel pick-up. Tour is two hours, offered throughout the day. Cost is \$207.01 for a single snowmobile. Rider must call the company to arrange pick-up (need to reserve at least two snowmobiles with a reservation to order the ground transportation online). **Dogsledding** – North Forty Escapes is the only company offering dog sledding in Park City. Cost is \$469.57 per sled (two adults) including hotel pick-up and all taxes. The tour is one (1) hour. Ski Equipment Rental, Lessons, Tours & Non-Ski Activities (Snowmobiling, Etc.) **Bobsledding** – Bobsledding is available at cost of \$175/person in Utah Olympic Park. Bobsledding is available on Saturday (3/27) or Tuesday (3/30). Transportation to the park will likely need to be arranged by Uber or taxi since we do not believe the Park City Transit service goes to Olympic Park. ## Picture Sharing Apps - Photo Circle App and Instagram

Photo Circle is an innovative, cross-platform, real-time photo-sharing app for Android and iOS-powered devices. One will be able to capture your memories in shared albums. It's fast, private, and simple. One can create albums for all occasions like weddings, birthdays, ski trips etc... Photos and video clips are securely and privately backed up to the cloud. There's no limit to the number of photos you can add or friends you can invite, and only members of the album can add and view photos.

Our trip will use this "Photo Circle" to share pictures from our trip. If you would like to participate, then follow the following instructions. First download the app to your phone. Then open the app. Next you should get a message if you want to "get started". Click on the blue "Get Started" button. Next create an account using your email and Password. (I think this is the easiest and safest option.) Click on Email/Password. Next you will get a message asking if you are joining a friend's circle or creating your own account.
